The Programme. What is the academic focus?

The application-orientated four-semester master's programme deals with science-related licensing issues in the broadest sense, and specifically in practice. It provides detailed information and knowledge of IT and IP contract law, as well as in related areas of International, and specifically Anglo-American, law. Additionally, a significant international content addresses the requirements of communication across national borders as well as communication where technology and law overlap. The specific global licensing management content, based on current and potential future requirements, is both innovative and challenging.

Practice Field. Which professional opportunities open up?

The course of studies is intended to provide specific knowledge for anyone seeking a job or career in international IT or media industries. Possible specialist fields could be legal or complex international projects, contract or license management. Moreover, knowledge gained can be applied to working in public institutions which use electronic administrative procedures (E-Government) and are consequently faced with numerous licensing issues, of both national and international scope.

Modules. What's the programme's structure?

The modules of the Master of Global Licensing provide the content for the student to be able to acquire the knowledge and competence in this specific aspect of the law.
